

# Analysis of Bullying in Public Services in the Education Sector Based on Pancasila Values

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Abstract: This study aims to inform that Bullying in the education sector is a serious issue that can have a negative impact on the psychological and academic development of students. This study aims to analyze the phenomenon of bullying in public services in the educational environment with the approach of Pancasila values, as the foundation of Indonesia's national ideology that emphasizes the principles of humanity, social justice, and unity. The method used in this study is a literature study that examines journals and books. The results of the study indicate that the application of Pancasila values in the school environment can strengthen relationships between students and reduce the potential for bullying behavior. Pancasila also has values in religion, social, unity, truth, goodness, and culture. Based on this, the University provides Pancasila courses (Mutmainah & Kamaluddin: 2019).

Pancasila Education is a course that has an important role in shaping the personality of students in higher education (Mutmainah & Kamaluddin: 2019). Unity of Indonesia The third principle contains the message that as citizens of Indonesia, we must remain united even though there are many differences between us. Unity in the third principle is very close to friendship. When every actor in the education sector understands this well, they will certainly respect each other and this can prevent bullying behavior. Democracy led by the wisdom of deliberation and representation Through the implementation of the values contained in the fourth principle, students can develop skills and understanding that enable them to be active in efforts to prevent bullying in universities or in the wider community (Sahrona, 2024).

Social justice for all Indonesian people means that everyone must be served fairly in terms of society, politics, and culture (Sari et al., 2022). For the benefit of the Indonesian people, the fifth principle will be successful if all Indonesian people follow it and apply it. Through the principles in Pancasila which have many humanitarian values, it will contribute to the development of good character for students or actors in other educational sectors.
